

GUIDELINES FOR STATE INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT FUND (SIDF)

1. All the schemes should be approved by the Cabinet Committee on Infrastructure (CCI)/ State Development Council (SDC).
2. The SIDF projects size should be ideally but not less than 50 lakh and should be submitted through proper channel only i.e. through the concerned department along with Non-Duplicity Certificate (depending on the local situation).
3. Mandatory tendering for all SIDF projects should be done for Transparency and competitive bidding.
4. Flood protection related projects should not be allowed, except in exceptional circumstances, where the concerned department will have to give sufficient justification. Not more than 1% of SIDF amount to be used for flood protection works; but should be for protection of public asset.
5. Land development or Minor-Irrigation or Command Area Development related projects should not be allowed under SIDF.
6. The Planning / Finance department would ensure monitorable targets (Physical and Financial) against each project before release of allocated funds to the line departments. The SIDF will be utilized by the Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh only for the purpose for which it is approved and it stands earmarked for the same.
7. No change in implementing agency will be considered once it is approved by the CCI/ SDC.
8. Tendering for all projects under SIDF sanctioned would be mandatory for ensuring transparency and competitive bidding as per the district based.
9. The State Government would ensure setting up a strong monitoring mechanism (including Third Party Monitoring, if necessary) to check the progress of implementation and utilization of fund at regular intervals.
10. Necessary sanctions/ approvals/ compliances including codal formalities required under the statutory or other regulatory regime as applicable would be obtained by the authority concerned for the project(s).
11. The concerned department would ensure that there would be no duplication of these projects with other schemes.
12. The departments concerned shall prepare necessary estimate of the approved project in conformity with the concept papers / DPRs approved by the Planning Department. No concept paper or DPR shall be entertained by any notified works department which is not in conformity with the Allocation of Business Rules.

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
